Parish Program Partnering Possibilities

- **Achieving For Tomorrow**

...a program based on a platform of prevention, rather than of cure. Help us stop the early stages of child tobacco, alcohol and drug experimentation in children, ages 10-13, before experimentation turns into addiction.

- **School Reengagement & Retention**

...drug use disrupts the development of cognitive abilities used for learning, reasoning, and communicating, in children. This is substance-induced brain damage, a leading cause for dropping out of school. Help us teach children's brains to relearn how to learn, to improve their grade-level reading and mathematics abilities, to re-enroll in school, and to graduate.

- **Secure Crisis Residential Centers**

The Secure Crisis Residential Center is not a goodwill shelter. This is a completely secure facility created from a law (The Becca Bill, 1996) that intends to prevent at-risk children from coming and going as they please, until a care plan can be established. It is the only facility in Eastern Washington where Police Officers and Sheriff's Deputies can take an at-risk non-criminal child that they find on the streets. The Becca Bill provides no state monies for the food, clothing or necessities of this program; the equivalent of the rights afforded prisoners of war by the Geneva Conventions. Shouldn't local at-risk children receive the same?
